Recommended Supply List

Welcome to all students entering the Sixth grade at Janson this fall. We look forward to a great year as we prepare you for Middle School. Responsibility, integrity, organization, and actively achieving one's best are of the highest importance to the Sixth grade teaching staff. To assist in this endeavor here are a few of the most important issues we would like you all to be aware of:

All students are expected to come to class prepared for the day with their supplies and all assignments completed to the best of their ability.

Agendas must be signed each night by a parent or legal guardian as this tool informs parents about nightly homework assignments and any issues that might have come up during the school day.

Parents, please provide a current email so we can add you to ClassDojo to help with communication.

Students who bring cellphones to school MUST have the cell phone turned off and in their backpack. If a cell phone is found outside of a backpack or is left in the on position during the school day, it will be confiscated and taken to the office where a parent will have to pick it up.

The sixth grade teaching staff has compiled a suggested list of items that your student will need for the 2018-2019 school year. We are alerting you of this before the summer begins, in hopes that you will be able to pick up many of these items (which go on sale starting in July at WalMart, Kmart, Target, and even Staples), before we begin the year.

Art Supplies

Work Supplies

- 2-inch, 3-ring binder - blue or black with at least 7 subject-dividers
- 2 College-ruled Composition notebooks
- 3 packages of 3x5 Lined Index Cards
- Boxes of Kleenex Tissue to donate for classroom use
- 3 Highlighters of any color (1 yellow)
- Bring a supply of regular #2 pencils (For Math)
- Mechanical pencils are fine for other subjects other than Math
- 1 each - black pen, blue pen, and red pen
- 1 package of 500-sheet college ruled 3-hole punch paper (can be kept at home)
- 1 Wired Earbuds/Headphones (Required)
- 10 Plastic Sleeves
