## Muscatel Middle School Uniform Policy and Dress Code

Muscatel Middle School follows the Rosemead School District Mandatory Uniform Policy and is designed to ensure students dress for the purpose of learning. All students are required to wear school uniforms DAILY to protect the health, safety, security of the school campus, the welfare of all students.

## In addition to the district's uniform policy, Muscatel Middle School must also follow the California Education Code dress code.

## According to CA Ed. Code students may NOT wear anything dirty, dangerous, or distracting.

First Period teachers will check daily for dress code violations.

Fridays are "Spirit Days". Students may wear the following: School t-shirts, Club t-shirts, school sweatshirts, green shirts or blouses with a collar accompanied with uniforms pants, shorts, skorts, skirts, or Bermudas.

## If the above options are not chosen, then the regular school uniform must be worn on Fridays.

Students not observing the uniform rule will receive detention, and will be required to change

- Bandanas, beanies, sweatshirt hoods, hats or any other head coverings shall not be worn.
- No facial-piercing jewelry (eyebrow, nose, lips), plugs or spiked earrings of any kind. Metal chains, spiked jewelry, black gloves, or military nylon belts with metal belt buckles are not allowed.
- "Sagging" is not allowed, pants with belt loops should be belted, and undergarments shall not be worn as outerwear and may not be visible. (All dress wear will be hemmed no stapled or rubber banded pants. Boys should not wear socks any higher than mid-calf.
- Halter tops, off the shoulder shirts, spaghetti straps, midriff shirts, midriff blouses, seethrough tops and revealing tops are not appropriate attire for school. Undergarments may not be visible. Students who arrive at school in inappropriate attire will be asked to change
- Shorts, skirts, dresses and skorts must follow the "fingertip" rule will be observed. If shorts, skirts, or dresses are shorter than the "fingertip" they are too short, and will be considered inappropriate.
- All articles of clothing, patches or buttons, which have slogans advertising alcoholic beverages, illegal substances, or bearing suggestive, offensive or demeaning slogans are not to be worn.
- PE clothes should NOT be worn under school uniforms.
- Jeans, sweatpants, or exercise pants of any kind are NOT allowed.
- Parents need to ensure that students' footwear will allow them to safely participate in all school activities.
