The new year will bring many new things to our Rosemead students. We are pleased to welcome a new principal at Muscatel Middle School, Mrs. Jocelyn Wilson. Mrs. Wilson brings a wealth of experience in secondary education with an emphasis in middle school grades. For the coming year, we will be expanding Arts opportunities to students in grades 4-6 and adding Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math (S.T.E.A.M.) labs at all schools in the district. We are also very excited to announce a new Dual Immersion - Mandarin program at Encinita Elementary School. The program will begin at our Encinita Preschool program this year and officially launch for Kindergarten students in the 2020 - 2021 school year. Over four hundred fifty (450) students attended summer school in our district this year at Encinita Elementary, Janson Elementary, and Muscatel Middle School. Students focused on foundational skills and enrichment opportunities to reinforce previous learning and prepare students for the new academic year.

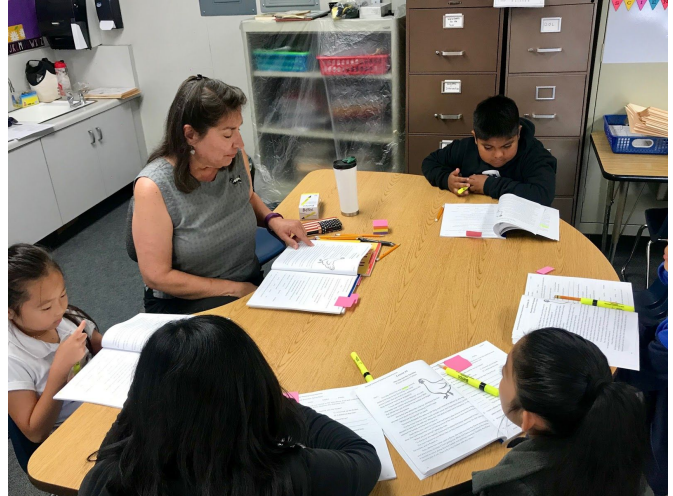
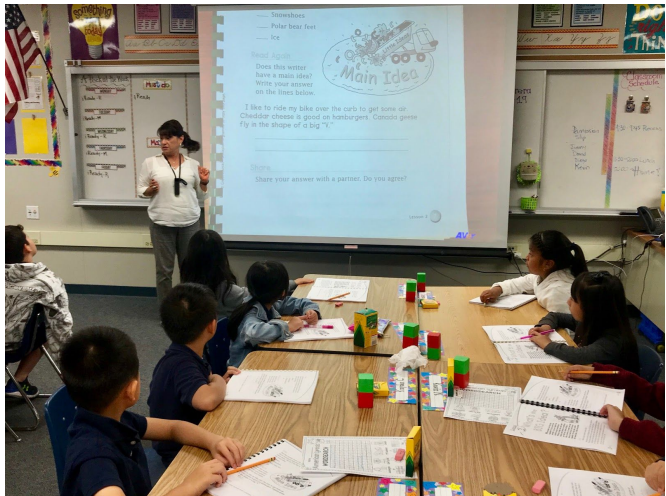
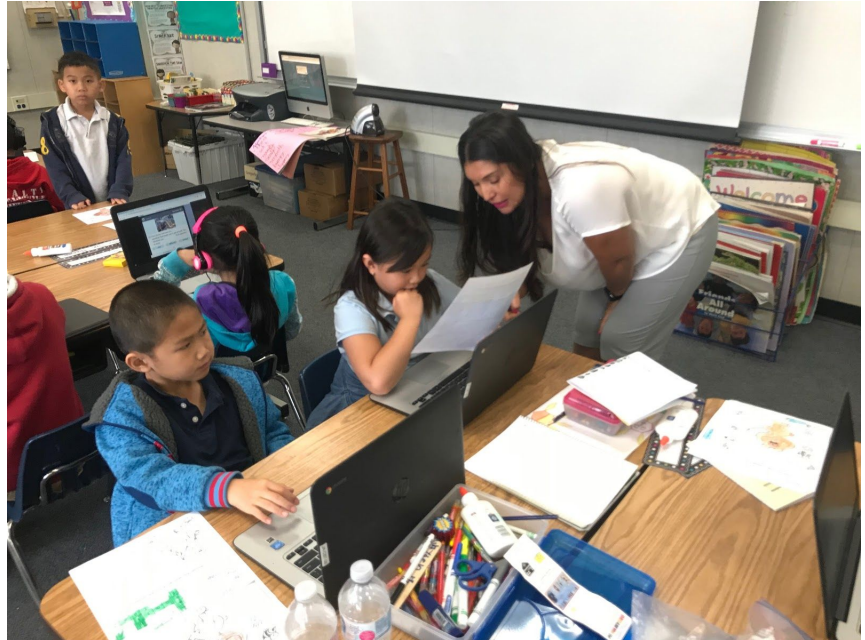


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SUMMER DAY CAMP 2019:

Over three hundred (300) students from preschool to 7th grade, along with volunteers from Rosemead High School participated in the 2019 Rosemead School District Summer Camp. Students continued academic studies in math and language arts, engaged in enrichment activities studying woodworking, science, engineering, film, 3-D printing, coding, dance, theater, singing, Spanish, needlework, arts and crafts, and geography. Students stayed fit by swimming at the Rosemead Aquatic Center, team sports, and morning exercises. To showcase their learning, students launched their rockets into the atmosphere, displayed their artistic creations, and demonstrated their talents in dance, song, and theater with a performance for parents and district staff.



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FACILITIES IMPROVEMENTS:

Our Maintenance and Operations staff use the summer as an opportunity for deep cleaning and facilities maintenance. This summer was no exception and our team thoroughly cleaned and prepared our campuses for the return of our students and staff.

Summers also provides us an opportunity to make major repairs and renovations. Thanks to the generous investment our community made to our district by passing several bond measures, this summer we continued much needed renovations at several school sites. We repaired and replaced classroom roofs at several of our sites, made major upgrades to our alarm systems, upgraded lighting in several classrooms, replaced over thirty-five (35) classroom air conditioning units at several sites, and completed the Shuey campus renovation that included new Smart technology boards for all classrooms.



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As you can see, our goal this summer was to provide additional learning opportunities for our students and to make sure our schools are safe, welcoming, and prepared for the new school year.
