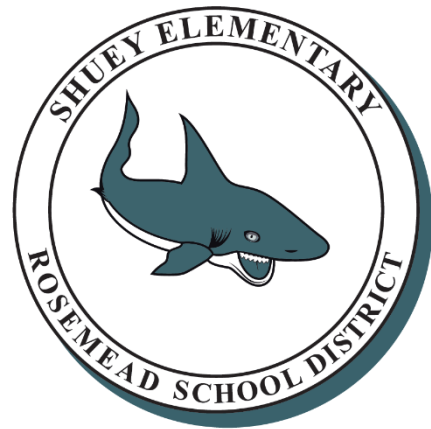
Rosemead School District Congratulated the Science Olympiad Team from Emma W. Shuey Elementary School for Being Awarded a Gold and Silver Medal
