Rosemead School District Announces its Students' Continued Academic Strides, as indicated in the California School Dashboard 2024 Data

Rosemead, California – On November 21, 2024, the California School Dashboard was updated to include 2024 data. The **California School Dashboard** is an **online tool** that shows the performance of K–12 schools and districts across the state of California. It provides information on state and local measures and shows how each school is doing in terms of student performance in reading, math, and other important measures of school quality. In addition to the Dashboard, we also collect and analyze other local data such as student surveys, teacher feedback, and formative assessments to gain a comprehensive picture of the whole child's development to ensure we are meeting all aspects of student growth from academic achievement to engagement and overall well-being.

The Rosemead School District showed steady and significant improvements over the previous school year, and all significant indicators were Green, indicating positive performance.

Additional accomplishments include:

- Improvement in the overall performance of students in Mathematics and a maintenance of effort by students in English Language Arts
- A 3.6% decline in chronic absenteeism over 2023, with a 5.6% decline since 2022
- A .6% decline in suspensions over 2023
- A 7.3% increase in English Learner Progress Rates

Other indicators of progress include:

- English Learner Progress Indicator:
 - 2023: Orange → 2024: Green
- Suspension Rate:
 - 2023: Orange → 2024: Green
- Chronic Absenteeism:
 - 2023: Green → 2024: Green
- English Language Arts (ELA):
 - 2023: Green → 2024: Green
- Mathematics:
 - 2023: Yellow → 2024: Green



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
