

IMPORTANT DATES & UPCOMING EVENTS:

Traditional Kindergarten (TK) and Kindergarten Programs Registration (Enrolling Now)

If you have a child or children who reside within the Rosemead School District boundaries and will have his or her fifth birthday between <u>September 2 and December 2</u>, they are eligible to enroll in *Transitional Kindergarten* (TK) program. Transitional Kindergarten is a first year of a two-year Kindergarten program that uses modified kindergarten curriculum that is age and developmentally appropriate.

If your child is approaching his or her fifth birthday after December 2, they are eligible to enroll in the *Kindergarten* program.
