In response to social media pranks and/or threats involving school districts across the country, the Rosemead School District wants to reassure you that our schools are safe and all our staff is vigilant to ensure the safety of our students and staff. While the social media and news reports may be alarming to some, the Los Angeles Sheriff's Department has not found the posts to be a credible threat to our schools, community or our students.

In the interest of communication, the Rosemead School District has several methods in place for anyone to report any threats, emergencies, or concerns which includes the **Rosemead Tip Line** available via the Rosemead Mobile App or visit our website at www.rosemead.k12.ca.us for more information.

Our Principals and school staff, have reassured students that they are safe in Rosemead and have asked them to be proactive by reporting any information (sightings, concerns, etc.) to an adult on their campus. The school district is also providing support to students who may have worries or concerns regarding the social media pranks and/or threats.

We ask that you remind your students to not post (repost) anything on social media that could be interpreted as a threat, even as a joke. It is important to be responsible and helpful to the authorities and not perpetuate the hoaxes. We are working closely with the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department to assure the safety and security of your children, staff and our community, and will keep you updated if any new information arises.
