Dear Rosemead Families,

We hope you are having a great summer, sharpening the saw, and taking some last minute vacation time before for the new school year.

Our district team has been busy recruiting new team members, providing summer nutritional services for students, modernizing our schools, upgrading technology, conducting maintenance, and preparing for the new school year. As previously shared, we are planning for the return of full in-person instruction in the fall. The Centers for Disease Control (CDC), California Department of Public Health (CDPH), and County of Los Angeles Department of Public Health (LACDPH) have all provided guidance that students should return for in person instruction with modified health guidelines. These guidelines include the following:

- Use of facial coverings (face masks) at all times while indoors
- Staff and student daily health self-screening
- Adherence to personal hygienic practices such as frequent handwashing and use of hand sanitizer
- Staying home when sick
- COVID-19 response testing
- Expanded classroom and campus cleanliness procedures

State and local guidance also indicates that in-person instruction can occur safely without minimum physical distancing requirement when other mitigation strategies, outlined above, are in place. As you are well aware, health guidance is subject to change as our health partners continue to monitor COVID-19. For the 2021-2022 school year only, school districts in California must offer an independent study option for students whose health would be put at risk by in-person instruction.
