Dear Parent(s) or Guardian(s),

It is hard to imagine a time when we did not know COVID-19 existed. The impact of COVID-19 on our lives, our activities, and our children have affected us all.

The responsibility is ours, as a community, to help stop this virus.

Children ages 5 and older are eligible to receive their COVID-19 vaccine. COVID-19 vaccines are safe and effective in preventing severe illness from COVID-19, and people who are fully vaccinated against COVID-19 may safely return to some normal activities such as in-person learning, sports, and visiting friends.

In order to make vaccination accessible for all our students and their families, we are hosting a COVID-19 vaccination clinic here at one of our schools. We have scheduled the clinics on Saturday mornings to give students enough time to rest should they experience any of the common side effects, including a sore arm, tiredness, or headache, that may occur after vaccination.

Students, parents, and the community may attend the following vaccination clinics:

- **Date/Time:** 1st Dose - November 13, 2021 - 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.
- **Date/Time:** 2nd Dose - December 4, 2021 - 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.

The vaccine clinic location will be at Emma W. Shuey Elementary School, 8472 E. Wells St., Rosemead, CA 91770.

Consent: Parents/guardians will need to be present to provide consent for their child's vaccination.

Registration: Registration is optional, and we will also accept walk-ins.
