WHAT IS TITLE I?

- Since 1965, Title I has been the largest federally funded program in education provided through *ESEA* (Elementary Secondary Education Act)
- Purpose is improved student achievement, staff development and parental involvement
- Funds received based on amount of Free & Reduced Lunch students at Janson School

HOW DID MY STUDENT QUALIFY FOR TITLE I?

- With the advent of Common Core, students are identified based multiple measures, such as grades, AR reading levels, Benchmarks, work habits, tests/quiz averages, SBAC data, and teacher recommendation
- Janson School became a School Wide Title I School to best meet the needs of all students.

GOAL OF TITLE I – STUDENT SUCCESS

 - Desires to achieve excellence
 - Perseveres through failure
 - Has a growth mindset
 - Knows when he or she doesn't “know”
 - And, gets help!

TITLE I SERVICES AT JANSON

Intervention classes that are part of the school day.

TK/Kindergarten

- **3 hour instructional aide**
- **Chromebook Carts**

1st-6th Grade

- **Chromebook carts per grade level, sometimes more than one.**
- **Community Liaisons**
- **Computer Lab/Library aides**
- **Supplemental materials for teachers to purchase and include in classrooms**

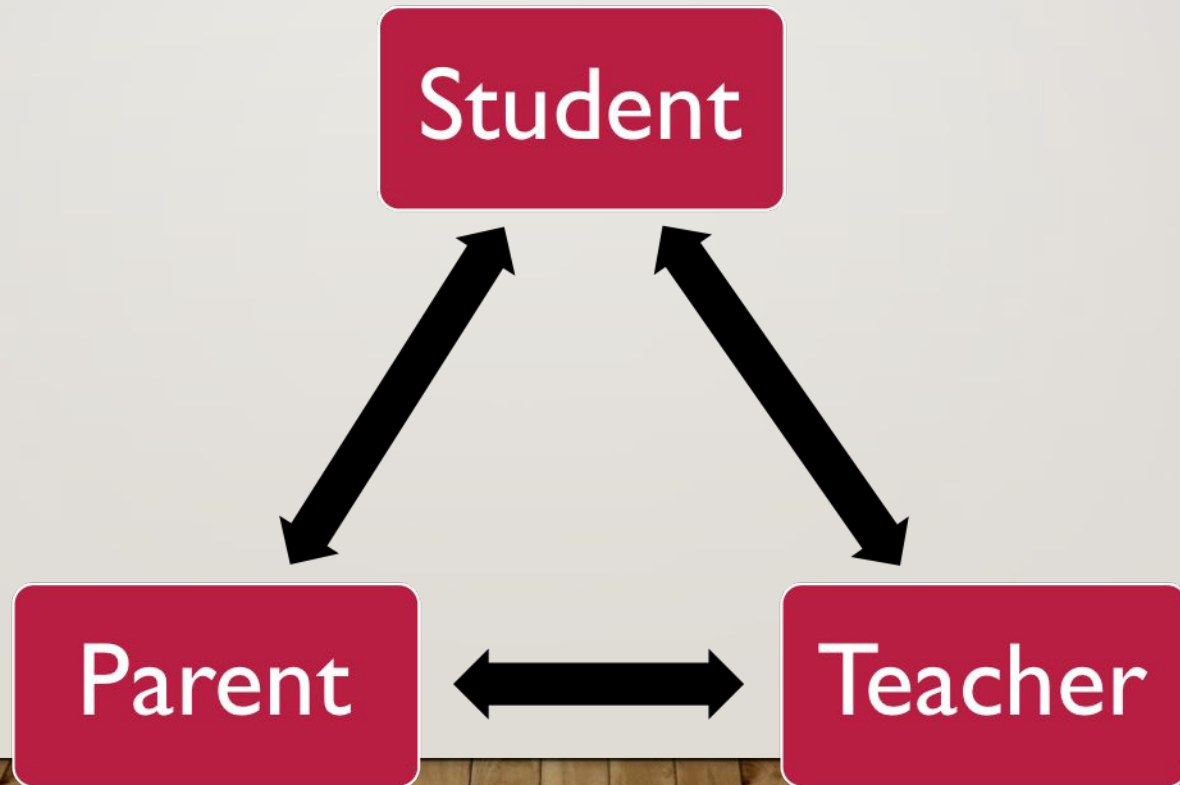
JANSON INTERVENTION

- Small class sizes – In all grade levels
- Designed to target students’ specific areas of need
- Our goals are to work on filling in “skill gaps” while also helping students in their current topics of study
- Intervention Block and Teacher available for all students.
- Academic Advisor to support students, parents and staff.

ADDITIONAL RESOURCES AT JANSON

- A.R. Program for grades 1st-6th Grade.
