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
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## Rosemead School District Welcomes Back Students for the 2023-2024 School Year with New Playgrounds at Encinita Elementary School and Mildred B. Janson Elementary School

The projects, which featured the installation of two new playgrounds at each school site, were started right after school ended for the 2022-2023 school year and completed just in time for the new school year to start. The overall project will include the installation of new playgrounds at all four elementary schools, with two school sites completed this summer. The playgrounds include new slides, swings, rubber flooring, and mascots, which students enjoy at the Encinita and Janson.

At Encinita, the new kindergarten playground received excellent reviews from the students. The Early Childhood Education students have a separate section with equipment specifically geared for our preschool students.
