### I. NOTICES - Public Comments / Speaker's Requests

As a result of the COVID-19 state of emergency, Assembly Bill ("AB") 361 was signed into law on September 16, 2021, amends Government Code section 54953, authorizing the Rosemead School District Board of Trustees to conduct meetings under AB 361's abbreviated teleconferencing procedures when the Board holds a meeting during a declared state of emergency, as defined under the California Emergency Services Act Government Code section 8625, and state or local health officials have imposed or recommended measures to promote social distancing, during a proclaimed state of emergency for the purpose of determining, by majority vote, whether meeting in person would present imminent risks to the health or safety of attendees, or during a proclaimed state of emergency when the Board has already determined by majority vote that holding the meeting in person would present imminent risks to the health or safety of attendees, subject to compliance with the requirements set forth in Government Code section 54953(e)(2). AB 361 provisions are set to sunset on December 31, 2024.

Effective January 1, 2023, through December 31, 2025, the Rosemead School District Board of Trustees

will adopt new procedures to continue holding public meetings in person and via teleconferencing pursuant to Assembly Bill 2449. AB 2449 was signed into law on September 13, 2022, and authorizes the Rosemead School District to participate in local agency meetings remotely based on the board members' own emergency needs or for other identified just causes if both the individual member and the local legislative body comply with the outlined procedural requirements, which generally include notice, board action to approve requests, and certain board member and public electronic and in-person meeting requirements.

The Board of Trustees values your comments. Pursuant to the Brown Act, Government Code 54954.2, 54954.3, and Education Code 35145.5, the Board cannot take any action or discuss a topic of concern until such time as the matter may appear as an item on a forthcoming agenda. Pursuant to Board Bylaw No. 9323, each individual speaker shall be allowed three (3) minutes to address the Board on each agenda or non-agenda item. The Board shall limit the total time for public input on each item to 20 minutes.

# California School Employees Association and its Rosemead Chapter 9 (CSEA) And Rosemead School District (District) Initial Proposal for Reopener 2024-25

In accordance with the agreement between the California School Employees Association and its Rosemead Chapter 9 (CSEA) and the Rosemead School District (District), CSEA proposes the following conceptual modifications, additions, or deletions to the current collective bargaining agreement between the respective parties.

CSEA reserves the right to advance other additions, deletions, and interests during this Reopener negotiations on all Articles and or Appendices. CSEA intends to negotiate the following:

### **Article IX- Salaries and Allowances**

CSEA seeks to adjust salaries for all bargaining unit members.

### Article X- Health and Welfare Benefits

CSEA intends to negotiate a higher contribution from the District and decrease the premium contribution for bargaining unit members.

### Article XI - Vacation

CSEA intends to clarify and change language for all bargaining unit members.

### <u>Article XIII – Transfers</u>

CSEA intends to clarify language and make changes to the transfer process.
