

# RESOLUTION NO. 21-22/22 TEMPORARY TRANSFERS FROM THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY TREASURY FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023

**WHEREAS**, sufficient cash is needed to pay obligations for current operating requirements lawfully incurred in the fiscal year, and;

**WHEREAS**, Article XVI, Section 6, of the California Constitution allows for borrowing from the county treasury, and;

WHEREAS, the following restrictions apply to this authorization:

- 1. Maximum amount of authorized borrowing: \$4.2 million.
- 2. For fiscal year: 2022-2023.
- 3. Shall not exceed 85 percent of the anticipated revenues accruing to the district.
- 4. Shall not be made prior to the first day of the fiscal year nor after the last Monday in April of the current fiscal year.
- 5. Shall be replaced from revenues accruing to the district before any other obligation of the district is met from such revenue.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Trustees of the Rosemead School District hereby requests the Los Angeles County Treasurer to make temporary transfers of funds.

# RESOLUTION NO. 21-22/23 AUTHORIZATION FOR TEMPORARY BORROWING BETWEEN FUNDS FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023

WHEREAS, sufficient cash is needed to pay obligations for current operating requirements lawfully incurred in the fiscal year, and;

**WHEREAS**, temporary transfer of cash between district funds is permitted by Education Code Section 42603, and;

WHEREAS, the following restrictions apply to this authorization:

- 1. Maximum amount of authorized borrowing: \$ 3.1 million.
- 2. For fiscal year: 2022-2023.
- 3. Amount shall not exceed 75 percent of any monies held in any fund.
- 4. Fund borrowed shall not be available for appropriation or considered income to the borrowing fund.
- 5. Borrowing shall occur only when the fund receiving the money will earn sufficient income during the current fiscal year. The amounts borrowed shall be repaid either in the same fiscal year or in the following fiscal year if the borrowing takes place within the final 120 calendar days of a fiscal year.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Trustees of the Rosemead School District hereby authorize the borrowing of cash between all of the district funds.
