I. NOTICES - Public Comments / Speaker's Requests

Effective January 1, 2023, through December 31, 2025, the Rosemead School District Board of Trustees will adopt new procedures to continue holding public meetings in person and via teleconferencing pursuant to Assembly Bill 2449. AB 2449 was signed into law on September 13, 2022, and authorizes the Rosemead School District to participate in local agency meetings remotely based on the board members' own emergency needs or for other identified just causes if both the individual member and the local legislative body comply with the outlined procedural requirements, which generally include notice, board action to approve requests, and certain board member and public electronic and in-person meeting requirements. Senate Bill 470 (Chapter 222, Statutes of 2025) extends certain COVID-era Bagley-Keene Open Meeting alternative teleconference rules, until January 1, 2030.

The Board of Trustees values your comments. Pursuant to the Brown Act, Government Code 54954.2, 54954.3, and Education Code 35145.5, the Board cannot take any action or discuss a topic of concern until such time as the matter may appear as an item on a forthcoming agenda. Pursuant to Board Bylaw No. 9323, each individual speaker shall be allowed three (3) minutes to address the Board on each agenda or non-agenda item. The Board shall limit the total time for public input on each item to 20 minutes.
