A. Review of Bid - Portable Restroom Building Project at Encinita ES Superintendent Ruvalcaba reviewed the location of the room on the campus, project bid timeline, costs associated with the bids, communication with the bidder, and reviewed visuals of the room location and nearby restrooms,

Superintendent Ruvalcaba answered Trustee questions regarding the bid process and project.

Clerk Armenta inquired whether staff will be conducting an internal audit of the documentation for each portable on all campuses.

Superintendent Ruvalcaba shared that staff already completed the internal audit in preparation for the fire alarm project that was DSA approved. Mr. Ruvalcaba expressed that staff will do further research regarding the Encinita portables documentation for exploration and adjustments to the internal process. See presentation attached.

After discussion, it was the Board's unanimous consensus to move forward with the Superintendent's recommendation as follows:

- 1. Reject all bids for the modular restroom project
- 2. Cancel the lease agreement for the modular restroom
- 3. Use room 30 for our upper grade severe needs students
- 4. The restrooms in room 27 will be shared by all severe needs students
- 5. Restrooms in the Multi-Purpose room will also be available for student use
- 6. Research and determine the feasibility of adding restrooms to room 26 during the school year or wait until summer of 2022

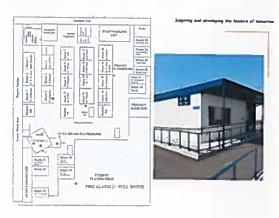

# **Project Timeline**

May 25 - Board provide the following direction:

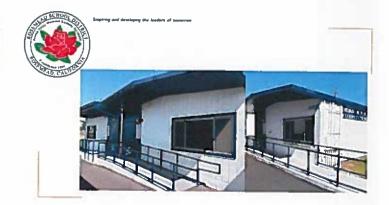
Proceed with the upgrade of portable 26 to include 2 restrooms through the bid process

Add a modular restroom in the interim while the project was completed May 25 - June 30 - Inspection and evaluation of the area, research and preparation for the projects
June 23 and June 30 - Legal Advertisements for the modular restroom placement
July 1 - Job walls and plans for the modular restroom conducted and released

Five construction companies were in attendance
July 6 - July 8 - Request for Information window for the project
July 16 - Project bids bids were open at a public meeting

Die bid was received from HGM & Co in the amount of \$235,000

A revised bid in the amount of \$198,000 was received July 23





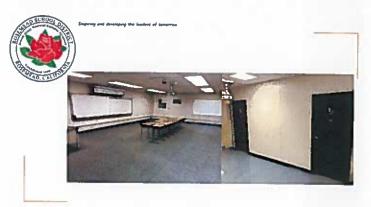




# Recommendation
